

## **TAUNTON MARATHON & HALF MARATHON – TERMS & CONDITIONS**

### **Entry Conditions**

All competitors enter at their own risk. While medical assistance is provided for the duration of the event no liability will be accepted by Taunton & District Carnival Committee Ltd and private land owners or individual race organisers for any injury incurred by entering this race.

Pictures and video footage may be used on the race website or that of our sponsors and in advertising material and media write-ups. All competitors entering agree to their photograph being used for these purposes.

### **Medical Conditions**

It is recommended that you prepare and train for this event. [www.runnersmedicalresource.com](http://www.runnersmedicalresource.com) has guidance. Please consult your doctor for a check-up if you have not exercised for some time. If you have a medical condition it must be detailed on the reverse of your race number provided. We strongly advise you seek medical advice before participating in this event and you disclose to those medical advisors the nature of this event.

For reasons of safety - No entries are permissible from participants on bikes, roller skates, with pushchairs, dogs or any kind of mechanical aid.

### **Your declaration**

By signing up to this event you have already agreed to the following:  
"I agree to abide by the rules of UK Athletics and the event. I understand that I enter the race at my own risk and that no person(s) or organisation(s) will be held responsible for any accident, injury or loss to myself prior to, during or after the event. I understand the organisers reserve the right to delay, postpone, cancel or not officially time the race in the event of adverse weather conditions or other events outside the organisers' control. The determination of what constitutes this is reserved solely to the Race Director. Photographs of the race will be taken for publicity purposes. I understand that my image may be used and give permission freely for it to be used. I understand that entrants under 18 years old require the permission of a parent or guardian to take part in the event. I agree to my personal information being used as described below."

### **Personal information handling in accordance with Data Protection Act (1998)**

We take privacy issues seriously and want to be open about the way personal information you provide when you enter our races is collected and used. We use the personal information you give us to keep you informed about race arrangements, to develop and enhance our event, and inform you about future events. We may pass your information to our race partners (Full On Sport) to produce results for the event. Your e-mail will never be passed on to other companies or third parties, other than the official race photographer. We will contact you using the email address you supply on your race entry form.

### **Complaints**

The organisers have taken every step possible to ensure this is a fun, safe and enjoyable event. The race has been organised by and with the help of volunteers to raise money for charity. We hope you will take the run in the spirit in which it is intended. If however, you do have cause for complaint please would you direct it to the Race Director at the Race Information Point where a formal written complaint can be recorded and duly noted. All competitors may also be asked to complete an on-line survey after the event in order that we may make improvements for future years.

**Runners Instructions** - Will be posted out to the address given from 10 March and published on the event website. You agree to abide by these.

**Race Numbers and Timing Chips** - Will be posted out to the address given from 10 March

### **Race Substitutions**

If you are unable to take part in the event you may pass your entry to another runner. By accepting a place in this manner the substitute runner agrees to the full Terms and Conditions of the event. No substitution shall be effective until the substitute runner has provided their full details to the organisers, such provision must be in advance of the starting time. Event Cancellation - In the event of the event being cancelled entry fees are not refundable.

**Accident and Illness Reporting** - In the event that you suffer illness or injury during the event, you are obliged to report it to the nearest marshal.

**Withdrawal from Event** - If you are unable to take part in the event you are not entitled to a refund.

### **Changes to terms and conditions**

We reserve the right to update our terms and conditions at any time. Please check regularly for any changes, which will be immediately applied to your continued use of our website.

### **REFUNDS POLICY**

From the moment we begin to organise an event, we start to incur costs. Your entry fee is invested into the cost of staging the event – everything from barriers to toilets, from printing to safety pins, from race numbers to marketing. Organising any event requires a considerable amount of forward planning, risk and expense. No entry fees will be refunded after 28 February.

Due to the nature of sports events we are unable to make exceptions for injuries or pregnancy.
